

# The Triumphant Entry

Luke 19:28-44

Jesus entered Jerusalem on Sunday.

Jesus had healed blind Bartimaeus.

He met with Zaccheus.

He explained He would be leaving them, but He would return.

**Zechariah 9:9** (Matthew quotes this passage)

Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion!

Shout, Daughter Jerusalem!

See, your king comes to you,

righteous and victorious,

lowly and riding on a donkey,

on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

# Psalm 118:25-27

LORD, save us! LORD, grant us success!  
Blessed is the King who comes in the  
name of the LORD. From the house of  
the LORD we bless you. The LORD is God,  
and He has made his light shine on us.  
With boughs in hand, join in the festal  
procession up to the horns of the altar.

## **Exodus 30:10**

Once a year, Aaron shall make atonement on the horns of the altar. This annual atonement must be made with the blood of the atoning sin offering for future generations. It is most holy to the LORD.

## Daniel 9:24-26

“Seventy ‘sevens’ are decreed for your people and your holy city to finish transgression, to put an end to sin, to atone for wickedness, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the Most Holy Place.

“Know and understand this: From the time the word goes out to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until the Anointed One, the ruler, comes, there will be seven ‘sevens,’ and sixty-two ‘sevens.’ It will be rebuilt with streets and a trench, but in times of trouble.

## **Daniel 9:27**

After the sixty-two 'sevens,' the Anointed One will be put to death and will have nothing. The people of the ruler who will come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end will come like a flood: War will continue until the end, and desolations have been decreed.

Nissan 10- Exodus 12:3 The date Israel was to select a  
lamb for Passover sacrifice
