NEHEMIAH'S REQUEST NEHEMIAH 2:2-5

- Esther 4:16-17 Sadness before the king could result in death
- May the king live forever- acknowledging goodness to the king
- Appeal to sympathetic concern for his own ancestors and hometown
- "What is it you want"
- Nehemiah PRAYED.
- James 5:16 The prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

NEHEMIAH ASKS TO BE SENT

- Isaiah 6:8 Then I heard the voice of The LORD saying,
- "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us"
- And I said,
- "Here am I, send me".

ARTAXERXES ANSWER NEHEMIAH 2:6-8

King asks, "How long and when will you return?"

Nehemiah 5:14 It would be 12 years

Nehemiah asks for:

diplomatic papers for safe passage and supplies

Materials to do the job (Citadel, walls, residence)

¹⁰ Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the bwiles of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of [c]the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
