# 1 John 1:8-10

<sup>8</sup> If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. <sup>10</sup> If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.



# The Goodness of God

**Psalm 116:5:** "Gracious is the Lord and righteous; our God is merciful"

**Lamentations 3:22–23:** "The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never fail; they are new every morning"

**Ephesians 2:4–5:** "But God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive together with Christ"



# The Goodness of God

**Hebrews 4:16:** "Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need"

**Exodus 34:6:** "The Lord, the Lord, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness"



# The Goodness of God

**Matthew 9:13:** "Go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, and not sacrifice'"

**Psalms 103:8-13:** "The LORD is kind and merciful. He is patient and full of love"

**Titus 3:5:** "He saved us, not because of deeds done by us in righteousness, but in virtue of His own mercy"
